STUDENT CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

Warm, comfortable, practical, old clothes are all that are required. Shoes should be sturdy and well broken-in. **Loafers, sandals, etc. are impractical** and their use causes unnecessary blisters, sprains and cuts. New sneakers will get dirty, so these also are impractical unless you and your child understand that this pair of new sneakers are meant for outdoor exploration and it is okay if they get muddy; you'll wash them when he/she gets home.

Laundry facilities are not available, so sufficient clothing for the three days should be brought along. All jewelry, expensive belongings and good clothing should be left at home. It is wise to put name tags on all personal belongings, as Camp Herrlich can not assume responsibility for lost articles. It is suggested that students include a small laundry bag or extra pillow case for dirty clothes.

This sheet "STUDENT CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT" should be taped, reverse side up, to the top of the suitcase. It is a generalized checklist that is used year round.

Camp Herrlich's outdoor program runs rain or shine. Rain gear in your child's baggage is essential!

Items left at Camp Herrlich are gathered and put on the bus before it leaves camp. Missing clothing may be found in the school's office.

It can get cold in the country. <u>REMEMBER TO PACK WARM CLOTHES AND BED GEAR</u>.
