Dear Friends in Christ:

In my memory Easter Sunday is always celebrated with trumpets accompanying the hymns at the festival service. There is no instrument quite like a trumpet to stir one's heart with excitement and joy at the resurrection of Jesus from the dead. Easter lilies are the preferred flower for Easter in part because they resemble miniature trumpets proclaiming the good news in every direction. When I was growing up our congregation's deaconess was the resident trumpeter. She played the melody to the Easter hymns, and my brother stood next to her, playing the descant part on his trumpet. I had started out learning the trumpet, but the band teacher switched me to tuba, so there wasn't usually a part for me on Easter Sunday.

When I came to New York I found out how hard it is to find a trumpet player on Easter. Everyone is booked well in advance, mostly at the wealthy and prominent congregations in the city. And if you should find a trumpeter for Easter, the cost is tremendous. I asked Deacon Carolyn Bensen if she had any contacts with a trumpet player for Easter Sunday at Grace. When she responded in the negative, I told her I could always play the tuba, but she declined respectfully!

We may not have trumpets for our celebration this year, but that doesn't mean our joy will be any less. The Festival of the Resurrection of our Lord is the chief celebration of the church year. It is a day not only to dress in our finest attire but also to offer our finest worship to God in thanksgiving for the gift of new life and salvation in Jesus Christ. Come prepared to rejoice with all the saints on this victorious day.

I encourage you to worship with us throughout Holy Week. Traditionally the services from Maundy Thursday through Easter are considered one extended service, because the whole history of salvation is recounted at worship on these days. The Benediction on Easter Sunday concludes the faithful service of Holy Week, but it inaugurates a great fifty-day celebration of the resurrection which lasts until Pentecost. I look forward to seeing you in church!


