Dear Friends in Christ,

In my sermon on Pentecost Sunday I spoke about some of the dreams and visions for ministry which have been shared with me by young and old alike over the past year since I arrived at Grace. Among these visions and dreams are: combining our two schools and aligning them more closely with the mission and outreach of the congregation; starting a children's choir and music program for young people; transforming the empty back lot into a community garden, memorial prayer garden, and recreation space; and serving the elderly and poor in the neighborhood with a soup kitchen. I also brought up the importance of developing a mission statement for Grace so that we can clarify God's purpose for this congregation. We have been given a variety of gifts by the Holy Spirit, but we bring them together in this place with the prayer that God will bless them collectively and manage them for the good of the church and the world.

With that in mind, I invite you to join me for breakfast on Sunday mornings at 9:00 a.m. during the month of July. Children's Church is being combined with the regular 10:00 a.m. service for the summer, so that hour is available for us to meet informally as a congregation to share in fellowship and talk about our future together. We will have an intentional conversation which will, hopefully, result in a mission statement which will guide our life together in the next few years. Everyone will have a chance to share their visions and dreams for Grace, some of which may be simple and easily attainable, while others will sound fantastic and impossible. But who knows what God can do? The first step in any endeavor is to bring it from the imagination to the lips, so that others can catch the vision and help bring it to reality.

I feel like this year has passed quickly. But I am also aware of how some things don't happen as quickly as we might like. There is a lot of work to do here at Grace. And much of that work involves changing the way we have been doing things. Change is necessary, because some of what we have been doing has not been working. But I also understand that change can be painful. I'm not a person who believes in change for change's sake. But I do believe that the church must change in order to survive, to thrive, and to be faithful to God's work in a changing world. There have already been some changes, such as in our worship, which have caused discomfort among some but which have been welcomed by others. I simply ask for your patience and openness. The Holy Spirit has called us to life together and common ministry. Let's trust that God is working good in this place for the church and the world as we strive to serve him in love and unity.
