Dear Friends of Grace,

Our Lenten pilgrimage is proceeding swiftly, and it is almost time to prepare for the important observances of Holy Week. Grace has been sharing midweek Lenten services with three other local congregations, and we have been meditating on the psalms. Wednesday, **March** 17th is our turn to host. We will provide a supper at 6:00 p.m. consisting of split pea soup, salad, bread, and dessert. At 7:30 we will go upstairs into the church for Evening Prayer.

Palm Sunday is March 28th. Children's Church is at 9:00 a.m. The service at 10:00 a.m. will begin with the blessing of palm branches and will include a responsive singing of the passion story according to Luke.

Maundy Thursday is April 1st. I invite you to join us in the Blue Room at 6:00 p.m. for an "agape meal." Agape is a Greek word for "love," and an agape meal is a tradition in some Christian churches that dates back to the early church. We will share a light Mediterranean-style meal of vegetable stew, spinach pie, Greek salad, pita bread, cheese, olives, and wine. A free-will offering will be collected. Pastor Rosalind Brathwaite and the congregation of Augustana Lutheran Church have been invited to join us. At 7:30 we will go upstairs into the church for a brief service of readings, songs, and prayers, followed by an informal celebration of the Lord's Supper. Foot washing will be offered to those who desire to receive it, and the evening will conclude with the stripping of the altar. Maundy Thursday recalls the events of our Lord's last evening with his disciples, the night when he was betrayed. Not only did Jesus institute the Eucharist on that night, but he also gave his disciples a new commandment ("mandatum novum") to "love one another as I have loved you." He signified this by washing the feet of the disciples and commanding them to do the same to others. Maundy Thursday calls all Christians to recommit themselves to a life of loving service in the world.

Good Friday is April 2nd. Good Friday is the most solemn day of the church year, the day of Jesus' crucifixion. There will be two opportunities for worship. At 3:00 p.m. there will be a Family Service that will include a children's version of the "Way of the Cross." Even though much of this service is designed to be accessible to children, all ages are welcome and will find it meaningful. At 7:30 p.m. the service will be the Liturgy of the Cross and the reading of the passion story according to John.

Easter Sunday is April 4th. We celebrate the festival of the Resurrection of Our Lord. There will be no Children's Church on Easter Sunday, because we want to welcome all our children and families to the festive service at 10:00 a.m. so that we can share together in the joy of the day. All are invited to a continental Easter Breakfast prior to worship, beginning at 8:00 a.m. After the service there will be an Easter Egg Hunt (in the yard, weather permitting) with a special visit from the Easter Bunny! This is the most important day of the year for Christians. I encourage you to invite your family and friends to join us on this very special day.

I look forward to greeting you personally in church in the coming weeks. I also encourage you to make a special Easter donation to our church as your faithful response to the gift of new life which is ours in the risen Lord Jesus Christ. May God grant us a Great and Holy Week!




